

## Our Church Interpretation Package

Your package can include:

- A VIS-BOX unit which creates a discrete wifi signal in your church allowing visitors to access films, photos, audio and documents directly to their smartphone.
- Visitor loan tablets to view self-led tours.
- Scripts for VIS-BOX tours e.g. church tour, stained glass windows tour, monuments tour.
- Tour maps.
- Paper versions of the tours.
- A new visitor guide booklet.
- A family trail booklet.
- A suite of learning resources suitable for formal and informal learners.
- New signage / noticeboards.
- Development of style guide i.e. branding for your church.

This list is for guidance only and can be negotiated and tailored to suit your needs.

## How the Package Works

There are two ways you can take the idea forward:

1. You have funding in place and we negotiate a package that suits your needs.
2. We assist you in completing a Heritage Lottery Sharing Heritage Bid. We have a great deal of experience of and success in making applications. We are willing to put the time into making the application at no cost to demonstrate our commitment to your project. If you wish to undertake a bigger programme we suggest opting for an 'Our Heritage' grant which is up to £100,000. We can help you with this too.

*We suggest you contact HLF to attend one of their awareness workshops, which are very informative. HLF is a very positive organisation to work with and they will support you.*

### Project Costs

## What you will need for a successful HLF grant bid

- A committed team to steer the project
- Support from your congregation and local community
- Evidence that you will have volunteers to help with the project
- To be able to tell some interesting stories about your church beyond the fabric of the building itself

You will not need to provide matched funding
